PROGRAM OVERVIEW

THE SILENT FEATURE OF THIS PROGRAM IS THAT IT'S A CASE-BASED LEARNING PROGRAM (CBLP). CASE BASED LEARNING IS AN ESTABLISHED APPROACH USED ACROSS DISCIPLINES WHERE LEARNERS CAN APPLY THEIR KNOWLEDGE TO REAL-WORLD SCENARIOS, PROMOTING HIGHER LEVELS OF COGNITION. THE CASE METHOD IS EXTREMELY HELPFUL IN FOSTERING EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING THROUGH A SELF-GUIDED MECHANISM. THE INDIGENOUS CASE STUDIES DEVELOPED ARE INTENDED TO ACCLIMATIZE LEARNERS TO AN ENVIRONMENT SIMILAR TO THEIR WORKPLACE AND ENABLE THEM TO REFLECT ON AMBIGUOUS SITUATIONS.
