METHODOLOGY

This program adopts the LEGO® Serious Play® methodology, an interactive and experiential learning approach that enables participants to explore complex decision-making challenges through hands-on 3D modelling. Rather than relying solely on discussion, participants use LEGO bricks to construct visual representations of ideas, assumptions, risks, opportunities, and decision pathways.



LEARNING OBJECTIVES

By the end of this workshop, participants will be able to:

- Structure and externalize how they perceive a complex situation moving from instinct to an organized picture.
- Through 3D modelling identify the drivers, constraints, and hidden influences shaping a situation while distinguishing what is known from what is uncertain.
- Make a reasoned, defensible decision that accounts for both certain and uncertain elements.
- Recognize how different perspectives produce different readings of the same situation.

PROGRAM CONTENTS

- Learning to read complex situations clearly before jumping to conclusions.
- Understanding what is driving a situation including what you know, what you suspect, and what remains unclear.
- Making sound decisions when you do not have all the information you need.
- Seeing how others read the same situation differently and using those differences to think better together.
- Identifying what changed in your own thinking and deciding how to apply it in your day-to-day work
